The Larry Prater Memorial Scholarship is open to seniors who plan to continue their education at a **2-year community college, business, technical or trade school**. Applications must be completed in full and returned to the Counseling Center, Bethlehem Central High School, 700 Delaware Avenue, Delmar, NY 12054, no later than Friday, April 1, 2022. Winners will be announced at the end of May.

These scholarships are being awarded in memory of Mr. Larry Prater, a long time employee of the Bethlehem Central School District. Larry, a disabled World War II veteran, retired in 1978 after 24 years of dedicated service to the District. Working at the high school for nine years in the position of Senior Typist and fifteen as the Main Office Manager Larry has long been remembered by many, not only at the high school, but throughout the District and the Bethlehem community in general. Larry was also instrumental in the formation of BCUEA and served as President of the union for many years. As an employee of Bethlehem Central, Larry stood out as an exemplary employee who was always willing to go above and beyond. His dedication to his job and his love of children were demonstrated in every aspect of his life.
